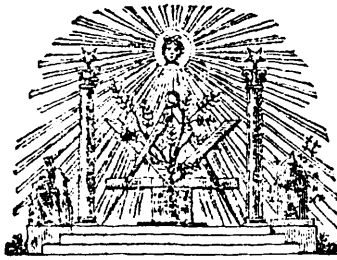

EXTRACTS

*Of the Deliberations of the R. : W. : Grand Lodge,
during the year 1825.*

SITTING OF FEBRUARY 19th.

On motion—Resolved that the following amendments to the general rules and regulations of the Grand Lodge be and the same are hereby adopted.

The Grand Lodge presided by the Grand Master and the other Grand Officers, is composed of all the founders of the Grand Lodge, of all the Past Masters who have been duly elected to preside in any of the Lodges of this jurisdiction, and who have or shall declare their intentions to remain permanent members of the Grand Lodge, of the brethren who had been Wardens of the several Lodges under our jurisdiction, previous to the election in the year of Masonry 5823, and who availed themselves of the privilege they then possessed of remaining members after their functions of Warden had expired by making application to that effect, and of the Representatives and Proxies of all the Lodges of the jurisdiction.

Resolved—That each of the Representatives and Proxies have the right of causing themselves to be represented in the Grand Lodge by a Brother of their Lodge who has held an office in the said Lodge, equal to the one held at the time by the Representative who sends the substitute. But the substitute is not entitled to fill the office of the Brother whose proxy he is if the said Brother should be an officer.

On each of the days of Grand Communication, all regular Masons to whatever degree they belong shall be admitted as visitor in the Grand Lodge.

If any of the Officers of this Grand Lodge, shall be absent for three meetings in succession, without assigning any reasons for his absence; such Officer shall be considered as having resigned his office.

SITTING OF FEBRUARY 7th.

On motion—Resolved, that a Masonic Festival shall be offered to our R. . . B. . . LAFAYETTE, whose arrival is announced in New-Orleans.

A Committee of Arrangement was appointed, and every necessary arrangement made, when in its sitting of April 14th 1825, the Columns being filled with more than three hundred Brethren, the R. . . B. . . Lafayette was introduced, and there received the most fraternal proofs of the respects which his virtues inspired ; after which he assisted to a most splendid banquet, ordered by said Committee.

SITTING OF SEPTEMBER 24th.

Resolved—That no diploma will be delivered by the Grand Secretary, except after receiving payment for the same.

Resolved—That the Grand Lodge will co-operate with the other Grand Lodges in the United-States, for the erection of a monument to the memory of our M. . . W. . . B. . . GEORGE WASHINGTON, at Mount Vernont.

Resolved—That the Committee of Correspondance will open a Fraternal Communication with the Grand Lodges of England, Ireland, Scotland and France.

SITTING OF DECEMBER 31st.

Resolved—That a diploma shall be sent to our R. . . B. . . G. M. Lafayette, (General) as an honorary member of the Grand Lodge of the State of Louisiana.
