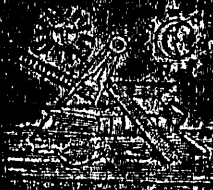

FORMATION OF THE GRAND LODGE

OF THE

STATE OF LOUISIANA.

The Grand Lodge of the State of Louisiana is constituted by the free and voluntary meetings of the Regular Lodges of the State, represented for life, by the Master of each subordinate Lodge who has presided over his Lodge during the term of one year, and temporarily by the Senior and Junior Wardens of each Lodge who are elected annually; and to said Grand Lodge they cede the power in governing the order, in administrative as well as dogmatical matters. All the Lodges respectively rendering the Grand Lodge the legislative and sole regulator of the Masonic order; likewise the depository and conservator of the general statutes of the symbolical degrees in this State.

MEETINGS OF THE GRAND LODGE.

The Grand Lodge holds its meetings in New Orleans, at Perseverance Lodge, No. 4, corner of St. Claude and St. Ann streets.

The Grand Lodge holds six meetings every year, as follows:

Four meetings fixed by the G. M. during the months of March, June, September and December, for the expedition of business.

One meeting fixed by the G. M. during the month of January, for the annual election of the grand officers.

One meeting fixed by the G. M. in the first fifteen days following the meeting for the election, for its grand annual communication and for the installation of the grand officers, at

which meeting all the Masons under its jurisdiction and all visiting brethren, are admitted.

The time of the grand annual communication is advertised in the public papers.

Independent of the six regular meetings, the Grand Master can call extraordinary meetings of the Grand Lodge.

The Grand Lodge does not admit in any of its meetings any Mason, except such as are members of other Grand Lodges or foreign Grand Orients.

Masons that do not belong to any Lodge, are under the jurisdiction of the Lodge nearest their residence.

AFFINITY OF THE GRAND LODGE WITH THE LODGES UNDER ITS JURISDICTION.

Each Lodge meeting in the city of New Orleans must at the end of each year, and before the election of the Grand Officers of the Grand Lodge, send to the Grand Secretary :

1st. The extract of the minutes of the election of the Master and Wardens, and of their installation.

2d. A list of its active members, stating correctly the amount of dues for the expired year.

The country Lodges have two months from the day of St. John the Evangelist, to acquit themselves of this duty.
